Agriculture:

Agriculture means growing plants like fruits and vegetables and taking care of animals like cows and chickens to provide food and other things.



Livestock:

Livestock are animals like cows, sheep, and chickens that farmers raise for food, milk, and other products.

Crops:

Crops are plants like fruits, vegetables, and grains that farmers grow for food.

Major Crops in Pakistan:

The major crops in Pakistan include:

- Wheat
- Rice
- Cotton
- Sugarcane



Wheat is a plant that gives us grains used to make bread and other foods.



Cotton is a plant that gives us soft fibers used to make clothes and other products.

Rice is a plant that grows in water and gives us grains that we cook and eat as food.



Sugarcane is a tall plant that gives us sweet juice used to make sugar and other sweet foods.

Processing of Crops:

People grow crops and make different products from them. It is called processing of crops.

Cotton:

- The farmers cultivate cotton plants.
- People get cotton from it.
- Machines clean the cotton.
- Clean cotton is spun into threads.
- Threads are woven into clothes.
- Cloth is cut and sewn into garments.

 Recognize that people process the crops they grow for making products (for example, cotton to thread to cloth and garments.)

Wheat:

- Farmers plant wheat seeds.
- Farmers collect the wheat when it's ready
- Machines clean the wheat grains.
- Clean wheat is ground into flour.
- Flour is used to bake bread, cookies, and cakes.



Sugarcane:

- Farmers plant sugarcane stalks.
- Farmers cut the tall sugarcane stalks.
- Machines crush the stalks to get juice.
- The juice is boiled to make thick syrup.
- The syrup is dried to make sugar crystals.
- We use sugar in candies, cakes, and drinks.

Importance of Livestock:

Livestock, like cows, sheep, and chickens, horses are animals that humans raise on farms. They are important because they give us many things we need and also help in different ways.
